

Dino Eggs

A fun variation on the baking soda and vinegar chemical reaction, your kids, from toddlers to teens, will love watching their dino eggs "hatch!"

- SUPPLIES

- 1 4lb box of ARM & HAMMER™ Baking
- Soda (makes 8-10 eggs)
- Miniature dinosaur toys
- A large bowl
- Water
- Vinegar
- Food coloring (optional)
 - Spray bottle for vinegar (optional)

— INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Add ARM & HAMMER™ Baking Soda to the bowl.
- 2. If desired, add several drops of food coloring.
- 3. Slowly add water in small amounts and mix until the desired consistency is reached; mixture should be damp and mold-able but not too wet.
- 4. Place some dough in your hand, then lay the dinosaur toy on top.
- 5. Cover the dinosaur with more baking soda mixture and then form it into an egg shape, tightly securing the dinosaur inside.
- 6. Lay your dino eggs on a baking sheet to dry overnight.
- 7. Chip away at the egg or use vinegar to dissolve the shell.
- 8. Watch them hatch!
